

## MEDICAL CLINICS SERVICES

There are community clinics throughout King County, providing some or all of the following services. Many have reduced fees adjusted according to household size and income. Most clinics accept Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) or Medicare and people without insurance. Please call the clinic closest to you for an appointment or for more information about the services they can offer you.

- ▶ Complete medical care for the whole family
- ▶ Family Planning and women's health care, including pregnancy testing
- ▶ Treatment for sexually transmitted diseases (STD)
- ▶ WIC food and nutrition programs
- ▶ Interpreters for those who speak limited English

## NEED HEALTH INSURANCE?

You may qualify for Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) Insurance. Washington Apple Health enrollment is open year-round. Apply now or renew your coverage.



If you are over income for Washington Apple Health (Medicaid), you may be eligible to purchase a Qualified Health Plan. However, open enrollment for a Qualified Health Plan is closed, unless you have a life changing event.

## WOULD YOU LIKE A TRANSPORTATION DISCOUNT?

**ORCA LIFT**, offers reduced transit fare for qualifying adults (19-64) to help reduce your transportation cost. Once you qualify for the ORCA LIFT program, you will receive an ORCA LIFT card registered to your name, with the same features as every ORCA card. Eligibility is based on your income for the most recent 30 days. If you are enrolled in Washington Apple Health (Medicaid/ProviderOne) or receiving Basic Food benefits you are already eligible for an ORCA LIFT card. Once eligible your fare in most cases is reduced to **\$1.00** or you can get a monthly bus pass for as little as **\$36.00**.

Your ORCA LIFT card can be used on the following transportation systems: Metro buses, Sound Transit buses, Link Light Rail, Seattle Center Monorail, King County Water Taxi, Seattle Streetcar, Sounder Train, Community Transit, Everett Transit, Pierce Transit and Kitsap Transit.

**Subsidized Annual Pass Program**, offers eligible riders an annual pass good on Metro, Sound Transit, Everett Transit for 12 calendar months and is renewable each year. To qualify, you must be on one of the six following programs, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Housing and Essential Needs (HEN), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Aged, Blind, and Disabled (ABD), Pregnant Women Assistance (PWA), Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA).
